- 21a Ca'del Console Prosecco Extra Dry** bottle £24.95
Veneto, Italy
A classic Prosecco with aromas of white peach, pear and flowers. The palate is fresh, not too dry, and clean as a whistle all the way through to the sparkling finish.
- 21b Prosecco Costaross Quarter bottle** 200ml £6.95
Veneto, Italy
- 22 Rosé de'Salici Brut** bottle £26.95
Col de Salici
A charming pastel pink colour, aromas of red fruit and pears, and a refreshing red cherry palate are lifted by a fine, delicate sparkle.

Champagne

- 23 Champagne Testulat Brut Blanc de Noirs** bottle £44.95
France
Light and subtle with notes of apple and quince; crisp and well-balanced in the mouth, with delicate bubbles.
- 24 Champagne Moët & Chandon** bottle £59.95
France
Very pale straw colour with small, active bubbles, with a subtle suggestion of flowers, vanilla, grapefruit, bread. This is a light and delicate champagne.

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White Wines

- 1 Pieno Sud Bianco (Grecanico/Inzolia)** bottle £17.95
Sicily
This blend of native Sicilian grape varieties offers ripe pear and red apple fruit, a hint of spice, and lemony crispness on the finish.
- 2 Pinot Grigio Terre del Noce** bottle £20.95
Mezzacorona, Dolomiti 125ml £4.00 175ml £5.50
Elegant, dry Pinot Grigio with apple and banana fruit aromas, floral lift in the mouth, and a clean, crisp finish.
- 3 Castel Firmian Sauvignon Blanc** bottle £22.95
Mezzacorona, Trentino-Alto Adige 125ml £4.75 175ml £6.75
A fresh, invigorating nose leads to a dry, citrusy, but still quite rounded palate. This roundness alongside a delicately mineral finish is typical Trentino.
- 4 Chardonnay** bottle £23.95
Tormaresca, Puglia 125ml £5.25 175ml £7.25
Bright, fruity, medium-bodied Chardonnay showing the purity and richness of Puglian fruit.
- 5 Pecorino Vellodoro** bottle £25.95
Umani Ronchi, Abruzzi 125ml £5.75 175ml £7.95
A refreshing, light-to-medium-bodied Pecorino, combining tangy green apple fruit flavours with hints of herbs, stones and almonds. The lively acidity lifts the palate, giving a finish that's as clean as a whistle.
- 6 Gavi di Gavi** bottle £26.95
La Contessa, Piedmont
This Gavi has a pale straw yellow, with green apple aromas and citrus fruit taste with a touch of minerality.
- 7 Vermentino di Sardegna "I Fiori"** bottle £27.95
Pala, Sardinia
A winning combination of depth and freshness on the palate this is benchmark Vermentino.
- 8 Casal di Serra Verdicchio** bottle £28.95
Castelli di Jesi Classico Superiore'
Umani Ronchi, Marche
Resplendent with flavours of peaches, apricots and apples against delicate hints of wild flowers. The palate is rich and textured, with a fresh underlying acidity and a sapid, saline note as a counterpoint to the ripe fruit.

Rosé Wines

- 9 Pinot Grigio Rosé** bottle £20.95
Nina, Veneto 125ml £4.00 175ml £5.50
Delicate in colour and an elegant nose of acacia flowers, this light-bodied dry rosé is delightfully refreshing.
- 10 Zinfandel Blush** bottle £21.95
Nina, Puglia 125ml £4.50 175ml £6.00
Inviting aromas of redcurrants and orange zest, followed by a creamy medium-dry palate showing a nice balance of sweetness and fruit flavours.

Red Wines

- 11 Pieno Sud Rosso (Nero d'Avola, Frappato)** bottle £17.95
Sicily
A juicy, well-balanced wine that captures the sunshine of Sicily, with a blend of ripe red fruit and spicy characters.
- 12 Merlot Terre del Noce** bottle £20.95
Mezzacorona, Dolomiti 125ml £4.00 175ml £5.50
Smooth, easy-drinking Merlot with plum and red cherry fruit, and a hint of dark chocolate on the finish.
- 13 Syrah (Shiraz)** bottle £21.95
Feudo Arancio, Sicily 125ml £4.50 175ml £6.00
This bold and spicy Syrah shows lush notes of wild berries, black pepper and thyme. The fresh acidity is perfectly framed by the lush, velvety tannins.
- 14 Castel Firmian Cabernet Sauvignon** bottle £22.95
Mezzacorona, Trentino 125ml £4.75 175ml £6.75
Intense, complex flavour with spicy notes, hints of eucalyptus and sweet fruit, and a fragrant scent of oak. Well balanced and full bodied.
- 15 Frescaripa Bardolino Classico** bottle £23.95
Masi, Veneto
The nose has aromas of cherries, wild strawberries and blackcurrant. Vibrant, fresh and aromatic on the palate, with hints of pepper. Light-bodied yet full of flavour.
- 16 Chianti Superiore (Sangiovese, Merlot)** bottle £25.95
Santa Cristina, Tuscany 125ml £5.75 175ml £7.95
Flavoursome, medium-bodied palate, fresh in structure. Typical spicy sensations from the oak.
- 17 Jorio Montepulciano d'Abruzzo** bottle £26.95
Umani Ronchi, Abruzzi
Flavours of ripe plums and red cherries give way to balsamic and savoury notes. The palate is full-bodied, with plush, velvety tannins and the finish is long and intense, with subtle notes of liquorice and spice.
- 18 Barbera d'Asti Fiulot** bottle £27.95
Prunotto, Piedmont
The palate it is well structured and soft, showing the typical red fruit and bright character of the Barbera variety.
- 19 Trentangeli (Aglianico, Cabernet Sauvignon, Syrah)** bottle £29.95
Tormaresca, Puglia **Organic** 
Structured but generous on the palate, with powerful blackberry fruit and excellent concentration.
- 20 Barolo** bottle £55.00
Prunotto, Piedmont
Complex nose with notes of rose, strawberry and forest fruits. Delicately floral, perfumed yet persistent on the palate, this is Barolo at its best.
